The COVID vaccine is available for all, depending on supply. Contact your primary doctor at ww.myhealtevet.gov for more info.

**Booster shots** for COVID-19 are now available at Veteran's Health of Indiana for those who have completed the COVID-19 vaccine series and meets the following criteria:

- For Veterans, their spouses, caregivers, or CHAMPVA beneficiaries
- Age 65 and older
- Age 18 to 64 who have an <u>underlying medical conditions</u> or self-report you are eligible for a booster
- Completed the Moderna/Pfizer vaccine at least six months ago at the VA or elsewhere.
- Completed the Janssen vaccine at least two months ago at the VA or elsewhere

For the Moderna vaccine or booster, walk-in and scheduled appointments are available at the Richard L. Roudebush VA Medical Center, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:45 p.m., Monday through Friday. To schedule an appointment, call 317-988-4899.

The Janssen vaccine or booster is available at select VA Clinic locations, call 317-988-4899 to check availability.

Bring your COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card to your appointment.

You may also receive your flu shot at the same time.
